## Novell eDirectory is First to Achieve SunTone Certification

Novell's cross-platform directory, [Novell NDS eDirectory](#), is the first directory service to complete the [SunTone Program Certification](#). Neither Active Directory, nor the iPlanet Directory have yet met SunTone requirements for scalability, availability, security, and optimization on the SunTone architecture.

This certification means that eDirectory has passed rigorous evaluation and demonstrated superior levels of reliability and quality on the Sun platform.

Obtaining certification under the SunTone program is another cross-platform milestone for the only directory on the market that runs across all leading operating systems, including NetWare, Solaris OE, Windows 2000/NT, Linux, Compaq Tru64 UNIX and very soon, IBM AIX.

This broad cross-platform support allows customers to dramatically reduce the cost of administering their mixed networks and get the most out of their existing technology investments.

"As the first directory to complete the SunTone Certification Program, Novell's eDirectory has proven to be an ideal service for the Solaris Operating Environment, adding features such as identity management and Web personalization to the Sun platform," said Blake Modersitzki, Novell vice president of strategic relationships. "The SunTone Program Certification, as well as eDirectory's demonstrated ability to support more than one billion objects on a single Solaris server, establishes eDirectory as a solid, reliable and key infrastructure component for the demanding service provider market, where Solaris OE dominates."

### Toronto Standardizes on Novell eDirectory to Manage IT Resources and Enhance Public Services

In an effort that will benefit 25,000 employees and 2.5 million residents, the City of Toronto has chosen [Novell eDirectory](#) as its corporate directory standard. This lays the foundation for the City's move into electronic service delivery. The two-phase, "Electronic Service Delivery Get Connected" project will manage human resource information, facilitate single log-on for its 25,000 employees, support and manage the City's extensive network resources and extend new services to Toronto's 2.5 million residents. The Novell eDirectory implementation is a joint [Novell Consulting/IBM](#)® Global Services partnership.

[Novell eDirectory](#), the industry's only secure, scalable, cross-platform directory service, allows organizations to centrally store and manage information across all networks and operating systems. At the [City of Toronto](#), Novell eDirectory will support such network operating systems (NOS) functions as user accounts, security and management of network resources.

By managing and integrating information stored in multiple directories and enabling single log-on for access to diverse resources in the distributed network environment, the City of Toronto will streamline administrative processes, reduce errors and omissions, save time and reduce expenses significantly.

The City has implemented new Web infrastructure, launched a new Web site and is actively building new applications to move into the electronic service space. Phase one of the implementation of Novell's eDirectory, will focus on Web activity external to the City's network.

This technology will position the City to provide services such as booking recreational facilities and obtaining parking permits online. Phase two, set for completion in summer 2001, will position the City to provide access to all services through a single log-on.

Novell counts banks, governments, manufacturers, industrial and Fortune 500 companies as users of eDirectory. Canadian customers include the Bank of Montreal, Hydro Quebec, Husky Oil, Government of Canada, and ministries within the provincial government.

"As part of our mandate to connect Canadians, Novell is committed to providing our governments at all levels with the IT resources and expertise necessary to respond to the needs of employees and citizens in the Internet age," said Don Chapman, vice president and general manager, [Novell Canada Ltd.](#) "Through Novell eDirectory, the City of Toronto will be able to centrally manage and integrate user account information across mixed platform environments, enabling employees, business partners and residents to work together in a truly integrated manner."

Available immediately worldwide to [Novell authorized education partners](#), the Quick Classroom solution allows for significantly reduced classroom setup time for Novell training, freeing technical staff, equipment and classrooms for billable training activities.

With increasing competitive pressure to trim administrative overhead, training partners will see immediate benefits with an impressive 70 - 80% reduction of the current setup time required for Novell classes. In addition, students will realize a richer education experience as hardware requirements for Quick Classroom allow students to move through class materials at their own speed, without having to work with multiple computers.

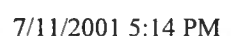
